



The <u>Action Plan</u> recognised the need for "policy recommendations on assisting young refugees (...) in their transition from childhood to adulthood (...) to be prepared in co-operation with the relevant stakeholders."

Adoption on 24 April 2019

## I. Philosophy, scope and purpose

- Legal status: Non-binding guidelines
- **Scope:** Young refugees having reached 18 who arrived in Europe as children.
- Purpose: Provides temporary prolongation of existing rights according to individual needs.
- Approach: Interdisciplinary and synergy between different sectors to support the young refugees' access to services they need.
- Philosophy: Opportunity-focused empower young refugees to enhance social inclusion.

- > active in reception and hosting centres or other social facilities for young refugees


