State Migration Service of Ukraine (hereinafter - SMS) presents its compliments to you and asks for urgent assistance - at a time that, without exaggeration, is crucial to the fate of our country.

On February 24, 2022, the treacherous attack of the Russian Federation on Ukraine, one of the founding members of the United Nations, marked the beginning of the war in one of the largest countries of Europe, which nurtured and strengthened peace for more than 75 years.

The aggressor country not only violated the established international rules of peaceful coexistence, but also cynically disregarded all moral principles. The army and mercenaries of the Russian Federation came to Ukraine to destroy and kill, including civilians.

Thousands of Ukrainian cities, villages and civilians are currently suffering from rocket and artillery shelling, air and ground strikes.
