


GUIDANCE AND TOOLS

- ☐ Poster on self-identification of vulnerabilities and special needs for persons fleeing Ukraine












MAPPING TRENDS


- ☐ Situational Awareness on developments relating to immediate response and implementation of TP

- □ Daily data on TP and weekly reception data (Ns of people leaving Ukraine and fleeing to EU+ countries and Ns of hosted in EU+ reception systems)
- ☐ Weekly analysis on asylum applications, TP and reception data (limited)
- ☐ The EUAA Survey of Arriving Migrants from Ukraine (SAM-UKR) is a rapid data collection initiative to gather information on displaced populations from Ukraine and address information needs at the global level.
