Initial response through EMN Ad-hoc queries

- LU EMN NCP AHQ on temporary protection launched on 3 March updated on 18 and 25 March
- ES EMN NCP AHQ on minors launched on 4 March
- AHQs on request of European Commission 28 March for internal use
 - Scope
 - Registration and documentation
 - Family reunification and tracing
 - Access to employment
 - Access to accommodation or housing
 - Access to education and training
- Follow-up AHQ on housing by private citizens on launched 4 May





Coordination mechanism established

- EMN established working group to coordinate information collection in order to avoid duplication
 - EU AA
 - OECD
 - COM policy units
 - NCPs
 - Involving also the information collection activities in the BluePrint Network and the Solidarity Platform
- Weekly meetings
- Clearing house for questions related to temporary protection
- Mechanism for ensuring quality of questions launched





Current activities

- Producing public outputs on the basis of information collected in March-May, updated and revalidated
 - Inform on Scope and registration published on
 - Inform on accommodation and housing to be published soon
 - Inform on access to services to be published soon
- Clearing EMN AHQs launched by Member States, recently:
 - EE AHQ on beneficiaries going back voluntarily
